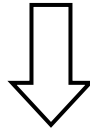
For puppies 3-12 months old.

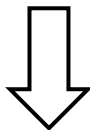


For dogs 8 months old and older who have already attended Introduction to Basic Obedience.

Basic Obedience I

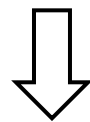
Our obedience courses are designed with the goal of achieving an AKC Novice obedience title.
